What the Course Fee covers

The quoted course fee includes full board accommodation in an en-suite room and tuition. More detailed information about the relevant course will be available from WI House on receipt of your Formal Application form and **non-refundable** deposit. PLEASE NOTE THERE IS A SURCHARGE FOR NON-WI MEMBERS.

Formal Applications

The number of places on each course is strictly limited and places will be allocated on a "first come, first served" basis, in the order in which fully completed Formal Applications (with the £50 non-refundable deposit) are received at WI House. Provisional applications by phone or email will not be accepted.

Members will be asked to indicate a second choice of course, should their first choice no longer be available. Prompt application is, therefore, advised once the Application Forms become available.

Accommodation at Denman College

All rooms at Denman College are now either en-suite or with private facilities, following the recent completion of the refurbishment of the Brunner Houses.

The majority of rooms are single, but there are a limited number of two-bed or three-bed rooms in the Main House, should members wish to share, by mutual agreement, with a friend. <u>Please note that these rooms are on the first or second floors</u>. There is provision for such an arrangement to be mentioned on the Formal Application form.

There are two specially adapted rooms for physically disabled people; these rooms have a second bed to accommodate any accompanying carer required to provide assistance. If the accompanying carer is not participating in a course, their full board accommodation will be charged at a concessionary rate.

We will do our best to meet particular accommodation requests, although this may not always be possible.

Transport to Denman College

The Federation aims to organise a coach with a single pick-up point at WI House. The cost of a return journey will be approximately £19. Places on the coach will be limited and will be allocated on a "first come, first served" basis.

Alternatively, you can make your own way to Denman by car/train/National Express coach. A pick-up by taxi from Oxford can be arranged by Denman College free of charge.

Application Forms will be sent to WI Secretaries in the September Secretaries' Mailing from WI House.

Secretaries can then produce copies and distribute them to their members, so that they can then apply as soon as they wish.

Application Forms must be returned to WI House <u>NOT</u> Denman College.
